



## Early Childhood Program (Nursery through Kindergarten) Application Checklist

- Tour:** Schedule a tour with Admissions Director Rebecca Kellich by email at [rkellich@holychildacademy.com](mailto:rkellich@holychildacademy.com) or by phone at 610.259.2712.
- Application Form:** Complete the application form at [holychildacademy.com/application](http://holychildacademy.com/application). All applications require a non-refundable \$40 application fee. You will be prompted to enter your credit card information to complete your online application.
- Recommendation Form:** If your child is currently enrolled in school, please provide this [Recommendation Form](#) to your child's classroom teacher as soon as possible, as we value their input.
- Student Visit:** Once your application is submitted, we will be in contact to schedule your visit. Students applying the early childhood program will spend the morning at Holy Child Academy (8:30-11:30 a.m.). In some instances, students will spend time in several early childhood classrooms.

**Testing:** While testing is not a primary requirement for admission, if we determine that we need more information after the social visit, we may require the applicant to submit the results of the WPPSI-IV (Wechsler Pre-Primary Scale of Intelligence). This test is administered at a number of educational testing services.

**Admission Requirements:** Admission for Early Childhood Montessori two-year-old program requires that the child must be two on or before August 31, 2019.

Admission for Early Childhood Montessori three-year-old program requires the child must be three on or before August 31, 2019. The child must be fully independent in the bathroom. Children who are not fully independent will be admitted to the two-year-old program until they are toilet trained.

**Financial Aid:**

Starting in Pre-K, financial aid is available for those families who demonstrated financial need. Files are reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis beginning in February. No financial aid awards will be made until a student has been accepted to Holy Child Academy. If applying for financial aid, follow the instructions in the Financial Aid pamphlet you received with the Holy Child Academy packet and begin the process with [sss.nais.org](http://sss.nais.org).
